Join us for an exhilarating Amboli macro photography tour, where you'll explore the hidden world of this biodiversity hotspot. Amboli, nestled in the Western Ghats, is renowned for its rich macrofauna, including a plethora of insects, frogs, and other small creatures that thrive in its lush, evergreen forests. In Tilari, our main focus is on gliding frog and bioluminescent fungi photography – experimenting with creative lighting and unique perspectives.

With fewer restrictions compared to Amboli, it gives us the freedom to explore, try new techniques, and push creative boundaries.

Tour Itinerary

5th July (Day 1) - arriving at our property in the daytime. After lunch a short introduction session & briefing followed by evening field session in search of amazing macrofauna of Amboli.

6th July (Day 2) - Daytime nature trails in the nearby area focusing on endemic amphibians & Reptiles. A photography session, on-field practical photography guidance, after lunch and indoor Editing session by skipper and heading towards evening nature trails, herping in search of reptiles, amphibians, and infinite macro species till late night.

7th July (Day 3) - Morning nature trail followed by breakfast and hotel check-out. We then head towards Tilari rainforest, with afternoon and evening macro shoots in the surrounding forest. After dinner, a special overnight session focused on gliding frogs and bioluminescent fungi photography.

8th July (Day 4) - Morning discussion reviewing what we've captured over the last 3 days, followed by breakfast and check-out. Tour concludes.
